- Employees: 77 faculty members and 66 staff members
- Students: 1,460 undergraduate students and 162 graduate students
- Degrees conferred annually: 211
- Programs: Physical therapy, occupational therapy and occupational science, communication science

and disorders, respiratory therapy, nuclear medicine, radiography, diagnostic medical ultrasound, clinical laboratory science, health sciences, health psychology, disability and policy studies, satellite pharmacy program

- Research funding\*: \$762,000 shared credit, \$2.6 million full credit

**Sinclair School of Nursing**

- Degrees conferred annually: 200 undergraduate and 109 graduate degrees

- Research funding\*: \$34.5 million shared credit, \$111 million full credit
- Expenditures: \$220 million

*\*Research funding amounts are calculated for fiscal year 2009. Because investigations have become increasingly interdisciplinary, the MU Office of Sponsored Program Administration calculates both "shared" and "full" credit figures for sponsored-research dollars expended by MU's schools and colleges. Shared credit numbers represent each academic unit's portion of the total amount expended on MU research. Full credit numbers, on the other hand, seek to assign a dollar value to the "productivity" of investigators working across disciplines, thus allowing the full value of a project to be reported multiple times for multiple units.*

*Unless otherwise noted, statistics on this fact sheet are reported for fiscal year 2010.*
